Tribal K is the new karambit designed by Doug Marcaida, knife designer and judge of "Forged in Fire". Available in fixed or folding blade. Its design is characterized by the shape of the very curved blade where, on the back, there is a serration that returns a cut similar to that of a saw.

The handle is engraved with recurring triangular motifs in Philippine Martial Arts.

Blade Coating: Physical Vapor Deposition (PVD)

PVD

(Physical Vapor Deposition) is a variety of vacuum deposition methods used to deposit thin films by the condensation of a vaporized form of the desired film material onto various workpiece surface. The coating method involves purely physical process such as high temperature vacuum evaporation with subsequent condensation.
